Our most popular configuration for schools had been Pentium IV computers 2.8 to 3.0 GHz with 1.0 GB of RAM, 40 GB to 80 GB hard drives, sound, Ethernet, CD or DVD player, keyboard, mouse, licensed MS Windows XP Pro including all updates, Open Office Suite (if desired) with default file types of Word, Excel and PowerPoint, including Adobe Acrobat Exporter (pdf), Java, Flash and a one year warranty on hardware and software loaded for \$200.00. This includes a 17" flat panel LCD monitor.

A less expensive option is for a Pentium IV computer with 512 MB Ram, 40 GB hard drive, same software loaded with a 17" CRT monitor for just \$135.
